Building the Passage


It begins with selecting the materials that allow for this space to open. Pure minerals whose innate attributes create an opening to the universe beyond.

With the shaping glass, a gift both ancient and new. The vessel that conveys both the immaterial light and the energy it unfolds.

With the release of the color Lapis. The human vision of the sea, and of space itself.

Finally, with the molding of gold. This noble material that links humanity to the divine, to the light, and to the sun.



Visualize....

A passage of stone, ancient in its quality, like the stone work of our spiritual ancestors.

A glass wall, changing and charming the light in its invisible folds.

A ceiling of lapis from which threads of gold, like rain, pour toward us.

One can walk through the passage in the light, or simply observe as the air moves the threads of gold like wheat in a field, creating its own natural rhythms.







The Gateway will be realized as a collaboration of three. The artist, the visionary and the participants.

The Gateway will be executed as a monumental art installation.

It is conceived as an esthetic and physical work of art that will emulate the emotion, and evoke the experience, of what is beyond the limits of our physical reality, our knowledge and our beliefs.
